TASK	METHOD	HAZARD	CONTROL MEASURES
Finding Washing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask client where washing is to be done if not in laundry. Always do washing at beginning of service so other tasks can be done accordingly 	Bending, Lifting, reaching, posture	Manual Handling Code of Practice and PPE equipment
Sort Washing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Put on gloves and apron if required Keep washing at arm length – not against the body Separate soiled/contaminated washing from other washing – TO BE WASHED SEPARATELY Separate whites from colours if requested by client 		
Washing Clothes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clean filter if necessary Add clothes then approved detergent Select cycle and turn on If time permits, check if washing is finished and hang out as per Work instruction for Hanging out washing
